Your renewal date is printed on your license that is hanging in the real estate firm you are licensed with. For Agents licensed before July 2010, the renewal date is typically every two years on their birthday in an odd or even year. If they were designated broker of a firm, it might be the date of the firm license.

After 2010, all agents licensed will renew on the two year anniversary of the date they are licensed. If an agent changes their license, the date they renew will change to the date of the license. Check your real estate license for your renewal date!

If your license is inactive, contact the Department of Licensing for information on your renewal.
